AREAS OF PRACTICE:

Personal Injury & Wrongful Deaths

Hollander Law Firm handles personal injury and wrongful death cases. Injury suffered to the body, or death caused by the result of an individual or corporation's negligence, recklessness, malpractice or inaction. Cases can include: car and truck accidents, slip-and-falls, defective products and medical malpractice.

Auto Accidents

Our firm handles auto and truck accident cases, including cases involving motorcycles, pedestrians and bicyclists. These accidents often result in serious personal injuries (catastrophic), death, and extensive property damage. Cases can include: defective products, distracted drivers (DUI, texting, driver fatigue, etc.) road construction and insurance litigation (Uninsured Motorists {UM} and Personal Injury Protection {PIP}).

Defective Products

Hollander Law Firm handles defective/unsafe products—cases where consumers are often seriously injured or even die due to manufacturing defects, design defects or a manufacturer's failure to warn of known dangers. Cases can include: defective consumer products (cribs, toys, etc.), defective automobiles (tires, airbags, etc.) and defective medical products (medical equipment or machinery). Our firm also has extensive experience in handling dangerous children's products.

Medical Malpractice

Our firm represents victims of medical malpractice. Medical malpractice is a form of negligence where an injury results from the failure of a medical professional (doctor, dentist, nurse, etc.), or medical facility (hospital or healthcare facility) to exercise adequate care, skill or diligence in performing a duty. Cases can include: failure to diagnose, medication errors, surgical errors, etc.

Nursing Home Abuse

Hollander Law Firm assists victims and their families when a caregiver (nursing home, health care nurse, etc.) fails to meet the needs of the senior, or when any physical, sexual, verbal, psychological, or financial abuse is perpetrated against the resident of a care facility. Cases include: physical abuse (wounds, bruises, fractures, etc.), mental abuse (derogatory comments, isolation, etc.), neglect (malnutrition, bedsores, poor hygiene, etc.) and exploitation (missing property or money).
